<b>Naturalization (5-step process for an immigrant to become a US citizen)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be at least 18 years old and of "good moral character"</li> <li>Be a legal permanent resident and live in the US for at least 5 years</li> <li>Apply to be a citizen with the US Citizenship and Immigration Services</li> <li>Go to an interview with the US Citizenship and Immigration Services</li> <li>Take and Pass an English and Civics test</li> <li>Ceremony and Oath of Allegiance (loyalty) to the US</li> </ol> <p>Majority have embraced our American culture and increased democratic participation of diverse people in our society and political processes.</p>

<b>Democracy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><u>Power comes from the people</u></li> <li><u>Direct Democracy</u> - a type of government where citizens make laws directly, good for small communities. Ex: Athens</li> <li><u>Representative Democracy</u> - a type of government where people choose representatives to make laws, good for large communities, also known as <u>Republic</u>. Ex: US</li> </ul>
<b>Monarchy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A type of government where most property is owned or controlled by the government, and some by private citizens. Ex: monarchies</li> <li>Creates a "head of state" (often dependent on government for everything)</li> </ul>
